Theresa Pollick updated all participants on progress of the Dussel/Salisbury construction project.

Half of the south side of the bridge (overpass) has been removed.

The water line work is under way and was to be completed by the end of the day on August 5.

Any necessary shut off of water has either already occurred or will not occur for 2-3 weeks.

Off-ramps are being completely reconstructed.

The current plan is to pour the new south side of the bridge early in spring 2010, subject to completion of all other necessary work.

Closing of the NB ramp will likely not occur until spring 2010.

Some changes to the signals at Dussel and Ford have already occurred and more sophisticated ratio signal program is to be installed, along with web cams, in approximately 60-90 days, if early funding is approved.

Mike Stormer, ODOT, initiated a discussion regarding safety concerns. He asked for all meeting participants to take the message back to our employees. In addition, Theresa indicated it would be helpful to have feedback from employees on what they have observed, especially at the SB Salisbury Road exit ramp. There was a good deal of discussion about this and some indicated the traffic had been backed up onto the highway, which Mike Stormer definitely wants to avoid. Several participants volunteered to get responses back to Theresa from employees.

The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, October 1, 10 a.m. at Huntington Insurance offices.
