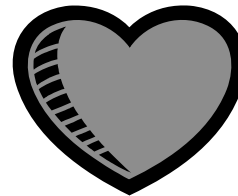

Eligibility

You are eligible to apply for an APA Scholarship if you meet either of the following criteria:

- You have worked for a member company for at least six months prior to the date of application.
- One of your parents has worked for an APA member company for at least six months prior to date of application.

If you are unsure whether your company belongs to the Association, call 419.897.6614 or visit arrowheadpark.org.

If your company is not a member, please ask for information about how to join. You and your company will enjoy many benefits as a result of APA membership.

Applicants must plan to attend a regionally accredited institution, pursue an associate, bachelor, or master's degree, and have a current GPA of 3.0.

The Scholarship Committee will also take into account financial need and the applicant's community service and volunteer contributions.

How To Apply

Applications are available for download online at arrowheadpark.org. You can also obtain an application packet from your company's APA representative or by calling 419.897.6614. The application form must be completed and submitted, along with two letters of recommendation and a personal statement, by March 15, 2006. The address to which you will send your materials is indicated in the guidelines attached to the application.

Scholarship Details

One or more scholarships are awarded annually for a maximum of \$1000 or one year of tuition, fees, and books, whichever is less. When you apply, we ask you to estimate your costs. The amount of the award is based on your costs minus any other sources of support. For example, if you attend a college where your tuition, fees, and books are \$2700 a year, and your company will cover \$2000 a year in tuition assistance, your award would be limited to \$700. Or if your child's costs amount to \$5000 a year and he or she has other scholarship support amounting to \$1500, the award would be the full \$1000.

The scholarship will be paid to the Bursar of the college you attend. Any unused funds at the end of the year will be returned to the APA.

Frequently Asked Questions

If I work for an APA member company, can my spouse apply for a scholarship?

Answer: No

What if my parents and I both work in the Park?

Answer: You may choose to apply either as an employee or as a youth. Your choice will not impact whether you will receive a scholarship.

If I win, can I apply again next year?

Answer: No.

Will I have to provide proof of employment to apply?

Answer: Only if you win. If you are selected as a winner, you must provide the Scholarship Committee with pay stubs to verify you or your parent's employment with an APA member company for at least six months.
