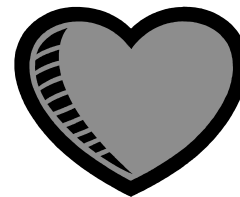

Volunteer Tutoring

The children of Burroughs School live in a working class neighborhood of South Toledo where life is filled with challenges. Their parents focus on keeping a roof over their child's head and food on the table.

Time to help children with schoolwork is limited. The parents need all the help they can get, and so does the school.

By becoming a volunteer tutor for the children of Burroughs School, you will do an amazing amount of good by visiting the school briefly each week for the duration of your volunteer tour of duty.

How to be a tutor

The classroom teacher for the child you are selected to tutor will prepare you for all of your tutoring tasks. The teacher will prepare necessary reading and other materials for each tutoring session. While training is available, most tutors find that the ability to read and a desire to help are the only skills needed to be an excellent tutor.

How much of your time?

As a volunteer tutor, you will:

- Visit Burroughs School one day a week for at least 5 weeks.
- Spend approximately 45 minutes at the school during each visit.
- If you wish to tutor the school's younger students, you will need to be at the school from 9:15-10:00am during each visit.
- If you are tutoring older students, your visit will take place between 3:15 and 4:00pm.
- Be asked to consider recruiting others to join the APA Burroughs tutoring team.
- Provide basic personal information to the school for an appropriate background check.
